



Creeping Juniper

Juniperus horizontalis



Shrub

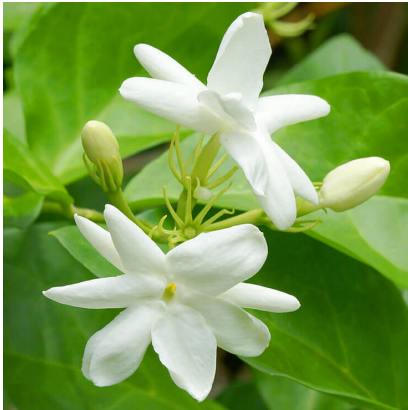
- The *Juniperus horizontalis* is a dense evergreen shrub. The branches are very long and flexible. It is often used for groundcover and erosion control.
- The propagation of this plant is done by cutting. The leaves are arranged in opposite intersecting pairs or occasionally in spirals of three.





Spanish Jasmine

Jasminum grandiflorum



Flowering Plant

- An evergreen shrub in the tropics with long, rather stiff branches. Leaves are compound with many small ovate leaflets.
- Flowers are 5cm in diameter, white, very fragrant and borne in clusters. Flower buds are pinkish in colour and floral initiation is promoted by high day and low night temperatures.





Indian Snakeweed Plant

Stachytarpheta indica



- Woody and erect shrub with long prominent spike of arranged flowers. Found in tropical environments with a distinct dry season.
- Woody stem has tan bark with linear-shaped lenticels. Salverform, blue to purple flowers have a white throat and 5 lobes (1.3cm wide).

Opuntia basilaris



Desert Plant

- Succulent with pad-like stems, usually growing up to 0.3m tall. Pad-like, bluish to greyish stems are covered by white to brown, wooly areoles.
- The areoles lack spines, but have small, reddish brown bristles called glochids.





Curry

Murraya koenigii



Host Plant

- Shrub up to 2.5m tall. Compound 30cm-long leaves are composed of 11-21 shiny dark green, lance shaped leaflets.
- Stems are dark green to brown, with numerous dots. White, funnel-shaped flowers (1.1cm wide) have a sweet fragrance. Flowers are arranged in clusters at the terminals.





Big Sage

Lantana camara



- Evergreen shrub with a rounded or spreading growth habit. opposite leaves are narrowly ovate to ovate with serrate leaf margin.
- Salverform, fragrant flowers are bright red to orange. Flowers are arranged in rounded clusters known as umbels. Fleshy fruits are known as drupes.

Ornamental
Plant

- A scrambling succulent, containing milky sap, multi-branched with spines all over branches.
- Stems are obscurely 3-5 angled, greyish brown, covered with many prominent grey spines.
- Leaves are simple, alternate, with oval-shaped entire edges.





White Butterfly Bush

Buddleja asiatica



- An evergreen shrub or small tree, able to grow up to about 7m tall. Leaves opposite, narrowly elliptic, measuring about 6-30cm long.
- Tiny white fragrant flowers are borne on slender panicles.

Red Flag Bush

Mussaenda erythrophylla



- An evergreen West African shrub. The bracts of the shrub have different shades, including red, rose and white.
- The star-like flowers of the shrub are 10mm in diameter and have single, modified sepal.

Peacock Flower

Caesalpinia pulcherrima



- Upright shrub, sometimes a small tree, able to grow up to 3-6m tall and with a spread of 2-4m wide.
- Green, turning grayish-brown as the stems become woodier, covered with spines, which swell at the base upon maturity.

Calamondin

Citrus microcarpa



Host Plant

- Medium-sized shrub, sometimes a small tree, able to grow up to 3-4m tall. Sparsely spiny along the stems.
- Simple leaves, elliptic-shaped and aromatic, measuring about 3-7cm long; dark green on the top surface and light to pale green underneath.

Tristellateia australasiae



Nectar Plant

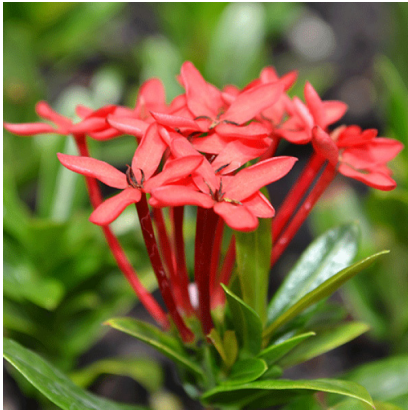
- It is a liana, up to 10m tall or more. Its opposite, stalked leaf have papery leaf blades that are oblong-egg-shaped.
- Its bright yellow-petalled flowers are 2-2.5cm wide, borne on flowering shoots that are 10-30cm long. Its star-shaped fruits are 1.5cm wide, with up to three developing from each flower.

Nectar Plant

- Ixora is a genus of flowering plants in the Rubiaceae family. It is the only genus in the tribe Ixoreae.
- The plants possess leathery leaves, ranging from 3-6 inches in length, and produce large clusters of tiny flowers.





Blue Trumpet Vine

Thunbergia grandiflora



Ornamental
Plant

- Plants may grow to about 20m in height and have long and deeproot system.
- The stalked, opposite leaves, which have a rough surface, are quite variable in shape. They may be triangular or ovate and the edges may be toothed, lobed, or entire.





Red Powderpuff Plant

Calliandra emarginata



- A woody shrub or small tree with graceful tiers of horizontal branches. Can be pruned and grown as bushy shrub.
- The plant assumes sprawling and low-growing form under full sun to partial shade.

Golden Barrel Cactus

Echinocactus grusonii



Desert Plant

- Barrel-shaped cactus that reaches up to 0.9m wide after a few decades, but occasionally grows up to 1.8m wide.
- Light green stem is initially ball-shaped, but later elongates and becomes barrel-shaped at maturity. When grown in full sun, the stem becomes densely covered in golden-coloured spines.

Desert Plant

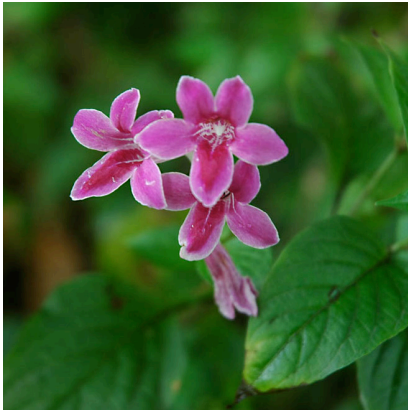
- Cactus-like succulent shrub with shallow root system, up to 0.3m tall and 1m wide under ideal conditions.
- Reduced to very small (0.5mm), dry papery remnants at tips of stem tubercles, no longer photosynthetic.

Nectar Plant

- A herbaceous creeping plant, commonly found growing as a weed rather than a garden plant.
- Leaves are green, sparsely hairy, opposite smooth-edged and egg-shaped to broadly lance-shaped. This fast growing species grows best under semi-shade or full shade, but plants grown in full sun require sufficient moisture.





Singapore Rhododendron

Melastoma malabathricum



Nectar and Host
Plant

- It is a shrub or small tree up to 5m tall. Its stems are reddish, covered with small scales. Its opposite, stalked leaves have leaf blades.
- Its flowers are up to 8cm wide, with petals that are light to dark magenta pink, or occasionally white. The flowers last only a day.





Prickly Pear

Opuntia cochenillifera



- Cactus with an upright, tree-like growth form. Tiny leaves occur on the stem where you would expect to find thorns.
- Hornless, light green stems are composed of padded-shaped sub-units (10cm long) which are linked together in a branched pattern.

Panda Plant

Kalanchoe tomentosa



- Small succulent plant with upright growth form. Young roots are red with white tips.
- Fleshy, oval-shaped leaves are densely covered in whitish hairs. Leaf tips have scalloped edge with dark brown spots.

Coral Vine

Antigonon leptopus



Nectar and
Climber

- Herbaceous slender-stemmed vine, climbs with tendrils arising from the ends of inflorescences. Heat and drought-tolerant when established.
- Leaves are soft, narrowly heart-shaped, light green and prominently-veined with wavy margins. Leaves are alternately arranged along the stems, simple and borne on petioles (stalks) that are 1-5cm long.





Water Jasmine

Wrightia religiosa



Ornamental
Plant

- Shrub having an approximately flat top and grows up to 2m tall. Thin, small leaves are light green, oval, and have smooth edges.
- Intensely fragrant, white flowers are composed of 5 obovate petals arranged in a star-like pattern. The black-tipped stamens are fused together at the tip in a column.
