

# CERTIFIED PRACTICING HORTICULTURIST REPORT (SAMPLE)

## DEFINITIONS

1. **Weeding**; taking out unwanted plants.
2. **Forking**; loosening the soil around base of the plants until 300mm deep without damaging roots of the plants
3. **Mulching**; cover soil at the base of the plant with compost. Thickness of the compost shall be 100mm.
4. **Fertilizer application**; broadcasting the fertilizer (organic or inorganic) at base of plants. The rate shall be approximately 100gm per plants.
